Three events were held and our 4-H members guided participants in the creation and use of a robot that was used to clean up a simulated toxic spill. Participants used teamwork and the engineering process to find the most effective way to clear the spill.

National Youth Science Day is an annual 4-H event that takes place during National 4-H Week, the first calendar week in October.
