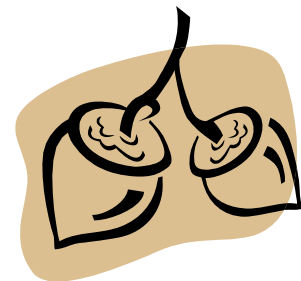

### **GRANT DEADLINE APPROACHING**

The Marin County 4-H Council has made available grant money for club projects needing financial assistance to grow, develop and serve the community.

The deadline for the fall grant cycle is September 15th. Forms can be found on the Marin County 4-H website. A date will be set for applicants to present their projects.

**We need three volunteer leaders** to review the grant applications for this cycle. Please call Allison at the 4-H office if you can serve on the grant committee for this cycle. The commitment is one evening meeting during the week after 9/15.

### **ENROLLMENT!**

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Returning families are encouraged to begin re-enrolling. The link to the enrollment instructions is:

Enrollment in 4-H has two parts – an online portion and a paper portion.

#### **Online Portion:**

Entering yourself and your children, and selecting their projects is all done online. When re-enrolling, you will use the button “I have a profile”. The e-mail you used to originally enroll in 4-H is your log-in. If you can't remember your password, just call Deborah at the 4-H office (415-499-4207) and she can reset the password for you. When you are ready to re-enroll, the 4honline website is: <https://california.4honline.com/>. If you have *any* problems, CALL!

#### **Paper Portion:**

While completing the online portion, you will want to *print and sign* the following forms:

1. Adult volunteers will need to print out and sign a copy of the Waiver form and a copy of the Confidential form and give these forms to their Community Club Leader, along with a check for \$6.00 made payable to the club. You will also need to print out the Medical form, fill it out, and give it to your CCL.
2. Youth members must print out and sign a copy of the Waiver and Medical forms and give them to their Community Club Leader, along with a check for \$15.00 made payable to the club.

### **New Leader Training**

To become a 4-H Project Leader, each person must have Livescan fingerprinting done and attend a New Leader Orientation. Please call the 4-H office at 415-499-4207 and we will send you a fingerprinting form with instructions, and sign you up for an Orientation.
